CLD's community-meal experience includes recurring workforce-development meals, nonprofit program service, family gatherings, staff appreciation and special events. We build each proposal around the population served, the program calendar and the organization's operating requirements.

SERVICE OPTIONS

Choose the service that fits the program.

Recurring Program Meals

A rotating menu delivered weekly, biweekly or on another confirmed schedule. Best for programs with predictable attendance and coordinated service days.

Individually Packaged Meals

Sealed individual meals for participants, staff, volunteers or off-site distribution. Packaging and dietary identifiers are confirmed in the proposal.

Full-Pan Creative Catering

Full-size chafing-pan selections for nonprofit events, family days, reunions, graduations and community gatherings. Most pans serve approximately 12-15 guests.

Special Events & Appreciation

Customized menus and presentation for funder visits, volunteer recognition, staff celebrations, graduations and milestone events.

Gift a Shift Partnerships

Sponsored or organization-purchased meals recognizing teams who serve others, including caregivers, educators and public-service staff.

One point of coordination

CLD confirms the menu, count, delivery window, facility access, dietary information, invoice requirements and responsible contact before each service period.

PLANNING BASELINES

Enough information to plan. A final quote built for you.

The figures below are planning baselines, not a public rate guarantee. Final pricing is determined by meal volume, frequency, menu, delivery distance, packaging, staffing, setup, dietary accommodations and payment terms.

Individually packaged program meals	From \$25 per meal Coordinated orders of 25 or more.	Distribution, staff meals or staggered service
Full-pan Creative Catering	From listed pan pricing Most full pans serve approximately 12-15.	Events and buffet-style service
One-time or customized engagement	Custom proposal	Special menus, staffing or multiple locations

Budget protection

A recurring-program price assumes coordinated counts and service dates. Delivery, servers, chafers, burners, disposable place settings, premium proteins and extraordinary facility requirements may be quoted separately. CLD confirms the complete price before service begins.

Clear from inquiry through invoice.

1. Program conversation

We learn who you serve, the anticipated count, frequency, location, funding or purchasing process and service goals.

2. Menu and service design

CLD recommends a rotating menu, packaging format, delivery schedule and staffing approach that fits the program.

3. Written proposal

You receive the confirmed scope, pricing, payment terms, cancellation terms and operational responsibilities.

4. Calendar confirmation

Service dates, counts and count-adjustment deadlines are assigned before production begins.

5. Delivery and documentation

CLD completes the confirmed delivery and provides the agreed invoice, receipt or supporting documentation.

6. Review and renewal

Recurring partners review usage, menu performance and future dates before the next service period.

One authorized contact • accurate meal counts • facility and loading instructions • dietary information by the deadline • purchase-order or invoice requirements • prompt approval and payment under the agreement
